
## SINGLE MICROWAVE OVEN NE1456







## Read instructions carefully before use

CATERING EQUIPMENT HIRE

- 1. Place the appliance on flat level ground.
- 2. If an extension lead is being used with this appliance make sure that it is fully unwound.
- 3. Plug the appliance into a 13 amp electricity supply.
- 4. Open the door the light will automatically illuminate, and a "0" will appear on the LED screen (FIG 1).
- 5. Place the required product into the oven compartment, and close the door. The light will go out.
- **6.** Select the required power level by pressing the power level selector pad **(FIG 2)** once. 1 will appear on the led screen flashing.
- 7. To select HIGH power press the selector pad (FIG 2) once IIII will appear in the led screen. For MEDIUM twice and III will appear for DEFROST three times and I will appear.
- 8. To set the required time (Max 15 minutes on High and Low 30 minutes on Defrost) press the number pads 1-0 (FIG 3) for example for 10 Minutes press 1 followed by three 0 this will be indicated on the led screen as 10 00.
- 9. Press the start pad **(FIG 4)** the oven lamp will turn on and the heating will begin. The power indicator will start to blink and the timer will count down.
- 10. When all time expires, beep tone will sound and heating will stop.
- 11. For a further 10 minute open and close the door and push the start pad (FIG 4).

## **SAFETY**

- 1. Under no circumstances should metal objects be placed inside the oven compartment.
- 2. You must check that any containers used are suitable for microwave ovens.
- 3. The product should be left to stand for approximately 2 minutes before consumption.
